- Bearded pigs are highly adaptable and have been observed utilizing fragmented mosaics of secondary forest and oil palm plantations, with signs of activity found in approximately 80% of surveyed sites.



DEPENDENCE ON FOREST PATCHES

- While they utilize oil palm areas, pigs remain heavily dependent on remnant forest fragments for nesting and wallowing, emphasizing the need for connected habitat corridors.



ECOSYSTEM ENGINEERS

- They play a critical role in turning over soil and controlling plant populations, though their high density in some plantations can cause significant damage to young oil palm seedlings.



AFRICAN SWINE FEVER (ASF) RISKS

- The 2021 ASF outbreak devastated wild pig populations, and high-density, localized populations in oil palm areas could be susceptible to rapid disease transmission.



RAPID POPULATION GROWTH

- Evidence from recent studies shows that despite the 2021 ASF crisis, surviving small, isolated clusters of pigs within, or near, oil palm areas can rapidly increase in numbers, with well-fed females capable of producing up to two litters of 9–12 young per year.



REPRODUCTIVE POTENTIAL

- The high reproductive rate in these habitats suggests that, with proper protection from hunting, oil palm areas could serve as potential sources for repopulating neighbouring habitats.
